Biss to Hold Town Hall Meeting on Budget and Government Reform

SKOKIE, IL – State Representative Candidate Daniel Biss (D-Evanston) announced today that he will host a Town Hall Meeting on Thursday, October 7 at 7:00 pm at the Devonshire Park Cultural Center in Skokie to have an open discussion with residents about their concerns on local and state issues.

“Since I announced my candidacy, I have stressed the importance of communication with residents of this district, because I believe that the best way to represent an area is to hear directly from people,” Biss said. “Everyday, I go door-to-door, and talk with residents about their concerns and what they think needs to be done differently in Springfield. This meeting will be another way we can continue that discussion.”

Biss has made it his main focus during the campaign to talk with as many people as he can to discuss the issues that are of the most importance to them both locally and on a state level. During his conversations with voters, many have voiced their frustration with current leadership in Springfield, the legislature’s inability to pass a balanced budget, and the culture of political corruption that has taken over government.

“People are angry and embarrassed right now with the way our government has been operating, and for good reason,” Biss said. “It is hard for people to have confidence in a system when we have felons for governors, and elected officials hand out unwarranted and unjustified raises to their staff.”

In addition to the Town Hall Meeting, the campaign will continue its collection of used cell phones to be donated for domestic violence prevention use. Anyone interested in donating cell phones for this cause is encouraged to bring them to the Town Hall Meeting on Thursday.
